REPORT OF THE WAY YOUR MONEY WAS SPENT

This is how your donations helped Mireya's family:

1. We met her at "her house" before Christmas and quickly realized that the main priority had to be to build her family a decent place to live as the conditions under which they were living were REALLY INACCEPTABLE. We also noticed that she only had food for a couple of days and nothing to celebrate Christmas so we bought her enough groceries, fruits and veggies that would last her for about 3 weeks. 2. We then contacted and met “Don José”, the builder who kindly agreed to build them a new house for less than half the price the other builders were quoting us on. He then gave us a list of the materials that would be required and he promised that in late January he’d work from daybreak until the sun went down to do the job.

3. The materials were bought after the festive season. (See the scanned receipts and a break-down of the way all the money was used in the excel document in www.condorspanish.com).
4. When some local residents heard about the project, they offered free assistance therefore allowing us to spend the money more wisely. (Transport of materials to the construction site, meals for the builders, and fees for the children’s current school year and the groceries for February were all provided by local residents)

We've just been told that she's already been given the windows. Hopefully Mireya and her children will be able to move to their house in 4 or 5 weeks max. We'll keep you updated.
